Principal's Message

It has been great to welcome students back after the Christmas holidays – and the school has felt focussed and purposeful this week. Teachers are busily preparing Years 7-10 for their Mid-Year exams and Year 11 for the second set of mock exams in February.

In my assembly with students on Monday we explored the importance of Resilience and Determination as behaviours for effective learners. We discussed a range of examples from Ellen MacArthur to Jesse Owens and the Wright Brothers to Archimedes who at some point must have thought to themselves "I can't do it...yet". It is vital that students accept failing as part of learning – we describe this as the First Attempt in Learning, and we recognise that only by failing, learning from failure and keeping going when we experience failure can we learn.

New Years Honours Celebration

We are thrilled to announce that Yassamin Sheel, who is the lead for our teacher training programme, United Teaching, has been honoured in the King's New Year's Honours List. She has been awarded an MBE for her services to education through her work as a teacher for 30 years and for her amazing work as a teacher educator. Students and staff will have seen Yassamin in school visiting our trainee teachers. Yassamin was instrumental in making our training programme one of the few to be awarded an Outstanding grade by OFSTED.
