RETURN TO AFTER SCHOOL SPORT - KEY PRINCIPLES

1. WHAT TO BRING TO AFTER SCHOOL SPORTS CLUBS



- Individual named water bottle
- Individual hand sanitiser.
- If you have had PE lesson on the same day of the club you will already be in FULL Kit!
- If you do not have PE lesson on the day of the club, bring your FULL PE kit to get changed into using the Changing rooms

2. ARRIVAL TO AFTER SCHOOLS SPORTS CLUBS



- Any equipment/training bibs used, will have been cleaned
- Hand sanitise on entry to the the session, using the hand sanitiser provided from the PE cleaning station
- CHANGING ROOMS - If you need to get changed into your PE kit access the Changing rooms. Advice will be given from your PE teacher on how to use the changing rooms. All Changing rooms have been cleaned prior to use.

3. DURING AND AFTER SCHOOL SPORTS CLUBS



- Social distance throughout the club
- Avoid contact with students
- Hand sanitise with your water breaks



- There will be no sharing of equipment outside your 'bubble'
- Equipment will be kept to the minimum
